KALAMAZOO ELECTRICAL JATC – Basic Requirements - *High School Diploma or GED, *Official High School Transcript, *Must have a passing grade of a “C” in Algebra (1 year of high school, or 1 semester of college), *minimum of 18 years old, *No felony convictions within the previous 7 years, *Drug testing may be a condition for employment, *Desire to work construction in all weather. Applications will be accepted at the KJATC Training Facility, 3641 E. Cork St., Kalamazoo, MI from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. All application information is due within 30 days of applying.
